



SCHOLARSHIP ANNOUNCEMENT

National University of Science and Technology Scholarships for International Students in Joint Master's Programs

The National University of Science and Technology "MISiS" through its "Program to Increase the Competitiveness of the National University of Science and Technology "MISIS" Among Leading Global Scientific Educational Centers" proudly announces that it is currently accepting applications for the 2014 International Student Scholarship Program from graduate students from our partner universities who plan to study in an engineering or technical field at MISiS for one or two semesters as part of their academic program or for up to two years for graduate students participating in a dual-degree program through MISiS. These highly-competitive, prestigious scholarships cover the entire period of study at MISiS.

Scholarship benefits:

The scholarship, which is designed to cover 1 or 2 semesters (not exceeding 10 months) with a start date of September 1, 2014, provides or grants:

- Free tuition to the National University of Science and Technology "MISiS" to study in one of the programs taught in English: Quantum Physics for Advanced Materials Engineering; Multicomponent Nanostructured Coatings. Nanofilms; Advanced Materials Science; and Advanced Metallic Materials and Engineering.
- Priority for rooms in student residence halls (ranked #1 among all residence hall facilities in Moscow!)
- A stipend that student will use to cover housing
- A stipend that student will use to pay for mandatory health insurance (if not covered by home country or institution)
- In total, funds amounting to 23 000 rubles (~460€) per month

List of required documents:

- Completed application with an attached color photograph (<http://en.russia.edu.ru/enter/2123/>)
- Letter of recommendation
- Cover letter in English
- Certified Russian translation of educational documents. They must be notarized or they must be authenticated by the Consular Department of the Embassy of the Russian Federation
- Copy of diploma(s); and a Russian translation of the diploma(s) that must be notarized or authenticated by the Consular Department of the Embassy of the Russian Federation. And, if applicable, a copy of any diploma supplement
- Copy of student ID
- Copy of transcript(s) translated into English or Russian
- Copies of certificates for scientific achievements (if applicable)
- List of publications (if applicable)

All documents must be submitted via email to mp@misys.ru with the subject heading "Special Scholarship Program_Last name_First name" **by 10 June 2014.**
