Information sheet regarding a cumulative dissertation

13th of June 2006

The candidate should be able to show at least 2 accepted scientific publications as a first author.

The "extreme" form of a cumulative dissertation, which only includes several publications put together without uniform formatting, is not wished.

However, a cumulative dissertation consisting of a detailed introductory section, thematically related and identically formatted publications, a joint summary, and a joint literature section may well be accepted as a dissertation writing.

12th of May 2009

It is specified that, in general, the supervising professor should decide what form of dissertation writing should be chosen and whether the results are sufficient to compile the thesis.

There are no objections to submitting a cumulative dissertation if the following minimum requirements are met:

- The writing should have a unified (superordinate) form, with introduction, summary, literature section, eventually a substance list, etc..
- At least two accepted publications (documented by a preprint or similar) should be the basis of the dissertation.
