## 73 degree programmes, 12 English Master programmes

The Technische Universität Bergakademie Freiberg is the oldest institution of higher education in mining and metallurgy in the world. Founded in 1765 to drive transformation processes and future technologies. - 21 Bachelor's programmes taught in German

- 36 Master's programmes, 12 of which are taught in English

## Application

In general, the application process for a degree programme requires the signed application form with personal information about the applicant, a school leaving certificate, any degree certificate that has been achieved so far (e. g. Bachelor's certificate) and a proof of language proficiency if your native language is not German or English.

However, some study programmes require slightly different application procedures. That's why you should visit the web page of the desired study programme (you will find it on the web page given above) and check the respective requirements, documents and the application deadline.

## Example:

- The English Master programme Mechanical and Process Engineering starts each year in the winter semester (1 October).
- The application deadline is 15 March (which means you have to start with the application process 6.5 months earlier than the beginning of the courses).
- To apply, you have to fill in a pre-selection form which will be available via the web page of the study programme 3 months before the application deadline <a href="https://tu-freiberg.de/en/studies/master-mechanical-and-process-engineering">https://tu-freiberg.de/en/studies/master-mechanical-and-process-engineering</a>

Your qualifications are now being assessed. After the committee of the study programme has given its okay by e-mail can you continue with the application process. You have to submit the following application documents as certified copies via mail, not only e-mail:

- Degree certificate in mechanical engineering, process engineering or comparable fields
- English language proficiency, proven by a recognised language certificate such as TOEFL, IELTS or equivalent

If your application documents have been checked without any objections, you will be admitted to the TUBAF after a few weeks and you will receive the Admission letter.
