#### Coming by airplane:

The Budapest Liszt Ferenc International Airport is located approximately 18 km away from the city centre. Budapest has international connections with all main cities of Europe.

The airport has a shuttle bus service (Airport Minibus Shuttle), which takes passengers to any address within Budapest, and even outside of Budapest as well. The desk of this service can be found in the Baggage Claim area or in the arrival hall. The cost of one-way travel with Airport Minibus Shuttle depends on the address you want to go, but the cost is about 3000 HUF (approx. 12 EUR) per person to city centre area where VITUKI and the recommended hotels are.

The other option is to take a taxi, which costs about 5000 HUF (approx. 18 EUR) to get to VITUKI or a recommended hotel.

#### Coming by train

There are three main railway stations (Keleti, Nyugati and Déli – East, West and South), which all are located close to the centre of Budapest. These railway stations are connected with all countries of Central Europe by direct fast and express trains, including Eurocity and Intercity trains. Each railway station is connected to a metro line.

From Keleti (East) Railway station take the red metro toward Déli pu (South Railway Station) and get off at Kossuth tér (Square) and change to Tram no. 2 toward Vágóhid utca (street). Vágóhid utca (street) is the south terminal of Tram no. 2. From Vágóhid utca (street) Tram no.2 terminal you can walk up to VITUKI in about 6-7 minutes on Kvassay Jenő út (street). The tower building of VITUKI can be located quite easily.

From Déli (South) Railway station take the red metro toward Örs vezér tér (square) and get off at Kossuth tér (square) and change to Tram no. 2 toward Vágóhid utca (street). Vágóhid utca (street) is the south terminal of Tram no. 2. From Vágóhid utca Tram no.2 terminal you can walk up to VITUKI in about 6-7 minutes on Kvassay Jenő út. The tower building of VITUKI can be located quite easily.

From Nyugati (West) Railway station take Tram no. 4 or no. 6. Get off at Margit híd (bridge) and change to Tram no. 2. and go to Vágóhid utca (the south terminal of this tram line). From Vágóhid

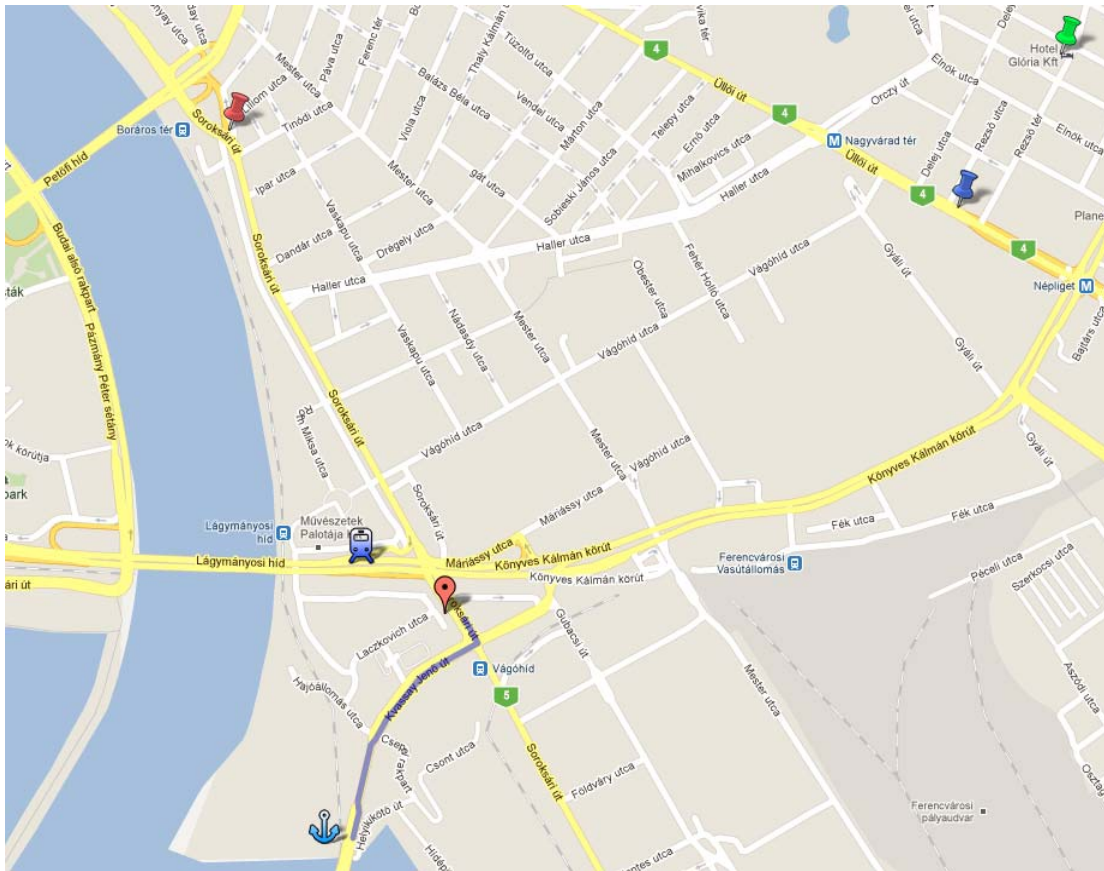
